Peace and greetings of God to you in this New Year! Please allow this Memo to provide more information on the Lasallian Youth Assembly (LYA). Joining this Memo are other YLA forms.

Here is a summary of the details:

- When?** Sunday, 18 July (registration begins approx. 2 pm) to Friday, 23rd July (ending with breakfast)
- Where?** Bryant University, Smithfield, Rhode Island
- How much?** \$300 for room and board, socials, and t-shirt per student and adult (excluding excursion-day activities)
- How Many?** **No more than 8 students with at least 1 adult moderator providing accompaniment.** *Note: We ask that if you have a majority of male or female students that one of the moderators be of the same gender as the majority of the students.*

When is the school registration form and deposits due?

Final registration materials & deposit No. 2 – **3 June 2010**

Cancellation Policy - It will not be possible to obtain a refund after **2 July 2010.**
