



Ultreia: derived from a pilgrim's call meaning "go further." Traditionally used to encourage fellow travelers along a shared journey, the word expresses perseverance, forward movement, and communal support. For the Lasallian Student Leaders Retreat 2026, *Ultreia* captures the invitation extended to young Lasallian leaders to continue moving forward together in faith, leadership, and community.

The *Ultreia* logo visually expresses the shared journey of student leaders formed through relationship, accompaniment, and action.

The three abstract human figures represent student leaders from diverse backgrounds standing together as one Lasallian community. Their upward movement symbolizes growth, participation, and active leadership rather than passive presence. This reflects the Lasallian value of accompaniment: walking with one another rather than leading alone.

The star above the figures signifies guidance, hope, and a shared vision. Rooted in the Lasallian tradition, it represents being led by faith and purpose and points participants toward something greater than themselves.

The upward arrow integrated into the wordmark reinforces the meaning of *Ultreia*. It symbolizes forward movement, encouragement, and the ongoing journey of discernment and leadership beyond the retreat itself.

The color palette reflects Lasallian core values:

- Blue: faith, trust, and Lasallian identity
- Gold or yellow: hope, purpose, and light
- Orange: energy, youthfulness, and engagement

Together, these elements communicate that LSLR *Ultreia* 2026 is not simply an event, but a collective movement that invites student leaders to grow, lead with intention, and continue the journey long after the retreat ends.
